In 2014, a woman was arrested for the slaying of her husband that had gone unsolved for six years. Det. Hasty was assigned to the case in 2012 and was able to obtain additional evidence against the primary suspect. She was convicted by a jury of first-degree murder in November of last year.

Just days later, Det. Hasty was the prime investigator into the brutal murder of a homeless man at a local park. A suspect was identified and arrested within hours of the crime, thanks to the work of Detective Hasty and his fellow homicide detectives.

“Detective Hasty displays dedication and dogged determination to seek justice for the families of the victims,” said Sgt. Mike Ogliaruso, Hasty's supervisor. “He works tirelessly for the citizens of Clearwater.”

## Recipe Riches

### Bunny Deviled Eggs

|--------------------------|-------------------------|
| 12 Large Eggs            | Carrots                 |
| 6 Tablespoons Mayonnaise | Celery                  |
| 2 Teaspoons Mustard      | 72 Mini Chocolate Chips |
| 1 Pinch Cayenne Pepper   | 1 Sandwich Bag          |
| Salt & Black Pepper      |                         |

#### Directions

Peel hard boiled eggs. Halve each egg lengthwise and scoop the yolks into a medium bowl, reserving the egg whites. Mash the yolks and add mayonnaise, mustard and cayenne; season with salt and black pepper.



Fill yolk mixture into a small sandwich bag, cutting a small opening in the corner of the baggie. Gently squeeze the bag to pipe the yolk mixture into the egg white halves.

Use the mini chocolate chips for the eyes and mouth.

Cut the carrots and celery to make whiskers and ears.
